Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to Badari Limestone Mine (5.76 Ha), M/s. ACC Limited, Mine code 38MPR18025 at Village-Badari, Taluk.- Vijayraghavgarh, District- Katni (M.P.)- 483501.


Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the verification of office records:

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail
11(1)	The modification in the approved Mining Plan for the above mentioned mine vide letter No. MP/Katni/Lst/MOD-73/2017-18, dated 15/01/2018 for the period 2018-19 to 2022-23. The deviation in proposal observed vis-à-vis approved document is given below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ In the year 2021-22 the total Quantity of ROM mineral production proposed is 49938 MT but only 2145.6 MT achieved.


1. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
2. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR, 2017 is not found satisfactory.
3. You are advised to rectify the violations of abovementioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
