Subject: - Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 of your Lalpur Limestone Mine over an area of 17.471 hect. having Mine Code 38MPR35295 situated in Satna district of M.P. State.

Sir,

Following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your mine during the scrutiny of office records & inspection dt.13.03.23:

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail
11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government. The Review of Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No.-MP/Balaghat/Manganese/RMP-10/2020-21 dated 14/10/2020 incorporating proposal of working from 2020-21 to 2022-23 and following deviations have been observed : (a) Only 2500 m3 of topsoil generated against the proposal of 7831 m3 of topsoil generation for the year 2021-22. (b) Only 6214 m3 of OB/waste generated against the proposal of 28162 m3 of OB/waste generation for the year 2021-22. (c) 24125 tonnes of mineral reject reported in AR against Nil proposal for the year 2021-22. (d) Only 50 m of garland drain is constructed against the proposal of 250 m for the year 2021-22. (e) Only 150 nos of plantations carried out against the proposal of 200 nos of plantations for the year 2021-22.
11(4)	The holder of a mining lease shall submit the mining plan to the competent authority for review at least one hundred and eighty days before the expiry of five years period for which it was approved on the last occasion, for mining operations for a period of five subsequent years. It is observed that Review of mining plan as required as per provision of sub-rule (1) of rule 17 of Minerals (Other than Atomic and Hydro Carbon Energy Minerals) Concession Rules, 2016 is not submitted till date. It is also mention that Minerals (Other than Atomic and Hydro Carbon Energy Minerals) Concession (Fourth Amendment) Rules, 2021, has prescribed amount of fine in schedule XII for late submission @ Rs. 2000/- per day w.e.f. date of notification i.e 02/11/2021. Thus there is violation of this rule.
26(2)	PMCP report for the year 2021-22 not furnished.
31(4)	The plans and sections required under these rules shall be maintained up to date within three months in case of category 'A' mines as referred to in clause (a) of sub-rule (2) of rule 55, and within twelve months in the case of any other mine The updated plans and sections are not submitted.
33	The holder of a mining lease shall, on or before the 30th day of June every year submit to the authorized Officer, as the case may be, and the State Government, a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32. Copies of plans and sections under rule 32 of MCDR-2017 have not been submitted.
45(7)	The following deficiencies were observed in the Annual Returns submitted for the year 2021-22: i. Part -V,S.No.3, the details wrt the reserve/resource were furnished incorrectly ii. Part -VII In the cost per tonne calculation, the details of DMF and NMET are not included.

- In response to violation letter dated 02/05/2023, your reply vide Letter No.06/23 dt-08/06/2023 has been received at this office in which rectification of violations done under rules 11(1), 26(2),31(4) & 33 are found satisfactory and considered as complied. But reply for compliance of rules 45(7) is not found satisfactory. Therefore, violation of Rules 45(7) of MCDR-17 still exists in above mentioned mine.
- In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
- You are, therefore, directed to show cause within a period of 30 days from the date of issue of this letter.
- Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
