The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during the inspection by undersigned on 23.07.2022 in presence of Shri Shri Bharat Gokharu, Shri T Shende and Shri Vikas Tiwari, Qualified person are detailed as below -:

नियम स.	पाए गए उल्लंघन की विस्तृत प्रकृति
Rule 11 (1)	According to this rule-No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operation in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Govt. pursuant to the provisions to caluse (b) of Sub Section (2) of Section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for exploration and Researching respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule of the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limit declared under schedule-A of the Atomic Mineral Concession Rules 2016/
	1. The Review in approved Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide this office letter No-MP/Satna/Limestone/RMP-25/2020-21dated 24.12.2020. (a) During the year 2021-22: It was approved to drill 62 no. of core bore holes in 200m x 200m Grid interval with 3100 meterage so as to cover the entire lease area in G1 scale, against which only 7 bore holes were drilled with 360.5 meterage. (b) Rafer table A8.8: It was proposed to construct retaining wall of 1736 meters length along toe of dump against which Retaining wall over 350 meter constructed
Rule 19	Where heavy earth moving machinery is used in mines, the holder of a mining lease shall maintain log books duly authenticated by the manager or mining engineer of such mines in respect of each machine showing date-wise account of hours worked, hours not worked, reasons for non-working, consumption of fuel or energy and lubricants and output of the machine during the corresponding working hours. (2) The summary of operation of each machine shall be recorded in the log book at the end of each month bringing out the percentage availability and percentage utilisation of the machine, average hourly performance and average fuel or energy consumption per hour. (3) The log books may be maintained in electronic form or in hard copy and shall be made available to the authorized officer on demand. The Log books of machineries deployed in the lease area are not found maintained at mine
Rule 26(2)	The holder of mining lease shall submit a yearly report as per the format specified before Ist July of every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative work carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reason thereof Aforesaid report in prescribe Form for the year 2021-22 not submitted to the Regional Controller of Mine, Jabalpur so far.
Rule 45(7)	If it is found that the holder of a mining lease or the person or company engaged in trading or storage or end-use or export of minerals, as the case may be, has submitted incomplete or wrong or false information in daily or monthly or annual returns or fails to submit a return within the date specified; then,—

(a) in the case of mining of minerals by the holder of a mining lease, the Regional Controller of Mines may advise the State Government to,-

(i) order suspension of all mining operations in the mine and to revoke the order of suspension only after ensuring proper compliance; (ii) take action to initiate prosecution under these rules; (iii) recommend termination of the mining lease, in case such suppression or misrepresentation of information indicates abetment or connivance of illegal mining;

Following discrepancies are observed in the Annual return submitted for the year 2021-22 Part I,Para 11, Item ii :- Period of lease is stated as 0 instead of 30 years

Para12: Contradictory statements are furnished in the annual returns in comparison to Review of Mining Plan submitted to this office (i)12.784 Ha area is reported under current working against 13.028 ha area.

Part II, para 2, Source of Finance is reported as Nil.

Part V, Para 4.1: Details of exploration carried out during the year 2021-22 is reported as Nil, whereas about 7 Bore holes drilled during the year.

- In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR,2017.
- 03. Non-compliance of the rule 11(1) and 45(7)of MCDR,2017 may lead to suspension of Mining operations under the provisions of rule 11(2) and 45(7)(a) of MCDR,2017.
- 04. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
