Subject:- Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect of your Chulhi Manjiyar Limestone Mine, over an area of 176.619 hectare, situated in village-Chulhi, Tehsil Rampur Baghelan, District Satna - of Madhya Pradesh State

Sir,

Undersigned has inspected your mine in the presence of your representative Shri D.K Singh (Mine Manager), Shri Santosh Kumar, (QP and Mine Geologist), and other mines officials on 02/11/2023. The document of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No. E 8818 MCDR-MPC0LST/48/2023-JBP-IBM RO JBP dated 07/02/2024 incorporating proposal of working from 2024-25 to 2028-29.

	1. Mining operations under mining lease.—(1) No holder of a mining lease shall commence or
	carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved,
	modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance
	with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of
	sub-section (2) of section 5. Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your
	mines at the time of inspection -
	1. Only 86864 tonnes of Limestone production is raised during 2022-23 against the
11(1)of	proposed 5,00,000 tonnes.
MCDR	2. Only 9041 m3 of top soil is generated against the proposal of 59,610 m3.

- 3. 39868 m3 Overburden is generated against the proposal of 1,59,172 m3 there by distorting the stripping ratio.
- 4. Only 500 saplings planted against the proposal of 1000 saplings.
- 5. It was proposed to develop 03 pits but only 02 pits were developed.
- Dumping was done outside the lease boundary and settling pond constructed outside the lease.
- 2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
- 3. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
- 4. You are advised to rectify the violations of above mentioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
