

Sub. : Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to Padwar Bauxite Mine over an extent of 25.82 hect. in Katni District (M.P.)

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 21/02/2024 by the undersigned, accompanied by Shri Abhay Singh, Mining Engineer of the Mine and Shri Maniram Yadav, Geologist of the mine.

Rule 11(1)	<ul> <li>No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016. Read with MCR (Amendment),2021notified in Gazette of India vide dated 02/11/2021</li> <li>The Review of Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter NoMP/katni/Bauxite/RMP-47/2020-21/424 dated 17-03-2021 incorporating proposal of working from 2021-22 to 2025-26 During the inspection it was found that following activities have been carried out with violating the approved proposals: - <ol> <li>Physical appearance of most of the boundary pillar were not observed on appropriate location as per the authenticated DGPS coordinates. Boundary Pillars need be fixed a fresh based on DGPS Report.</li> </ol> </li> <li>Exploration was not done as per the proposals given in the approved Review of Mining Plan. Eight no. of core boreholes of 120m total meterage proposed against 2020-21, Nine no. of core boreholes of 125m total meterage and 2 tril pits of 6mX6mX6m each proposed against 2021-22 and Three trial Pits of 6mX6mX6m size each proposed against 2022-23 have not been carried out so far.</li> <li>In the year 2022-23 it was proposed to produce 32828 metric tons Bauxite with removal of 7447cum Over Burden/Sub burden /inter Burden/ Burden/ mine waste including lateritic soil. 12(3)	The holder of a mining lease shall carry out detailed exploration (G1 level) over the entire potentially mineralized area under the mining lease with in a period of five year from the date of execution of lease or enforcement of MCDR,2017. So far out of 25.82hect lease area only 18.41hect area have covered under general exploration and rest 7.41hect lease area have considered as prospected. Thus, entire mineralized area of 25.82hect lease area has yet to be explored under G1 level. Thus, there is violation of rule 12(3) of MCDR,2017.		
Rule 31(4)	The plans and sections required under these rules shall be maintained up to date within three months in case of category 'A' mines as referred to in clause (a) of sub-rule (2) of rule 55, and within twelve months in case of any other mine The plans & sections were not found updated on quarterly basis as required under this rule

		Rent both cannot be charged at a time. So, information furnished in this regard needs correction.

	:	Entire ROM ore produced from the mine during the year (22960tone) is reported as
		cement grade production under Grade wise production of mineral. Beside this
		production of 150tone refractory grade bauxite is also reported under grade wise
		production where as there was no opening stock of ROM at the beginning of the year
		under consideration. Anomaly may be rectify. 5. Part – VII Cost of production: -
		i. In calculation of cost of production taxes had not taken into account. Necessary changes
		need be incorporated.
		ii. In calculation of cost of production along with royalty dead rent also has taken into account
		which is not correct. Necessary changes need be incorporated.

2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.

3. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 are not found satisfactory. In case Non-compliance of Rule 45(7) of MCDR-2017, Necessary action shall be initiated as deemed fit.

4. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
