Sub.: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to **Saliya pahari Limestone Mine , 38MPR47128, Area 4.12 hectare**, in District Katni of Madhya Pradesh.

Sir,

The following provision of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during the inspection by the undersigned on 15.09.2023 in presence of Shri.Manoj Kumar Manager (Mines) and Shri Arvind Kumar (Geologist).

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail
Rule 11(1)	<p><i>No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5.</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The benches in the Mine found not systematically maintained which resulted creation of high wall. 2. Boundary pillars are not established at the precise locations. 3. The deviation in the proposed location found between N 2652900 to 2653000 and E 447350 to E 447450.
Rule 31(4)	<p><i>The plans and sections required under these rules shall be maintained up to date within three months in case of category 'A' mines as referred to in clause (a) of sub-rule (2) of rule 55, and within twelve months in the case of any other mine</i></p> <p>The updated plans and sections are not matching with actual field conditions.</p>

2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
3. Non compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR, 2017 may lead to suspension of mining operation under the provision of rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017.
4. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within a period of 45 days from the date of issue of this letter.
