Sub.: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to your **Bhatiakala Limestone Mine (107.785 ha), Mine Code 38MPR35294** in Bhatiakala of Satna Dist M.P.

Sir,

The following provision of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during the inspection by the undersigned on **11.12.2023** in presence of Shri. Anil Kumar, Manager(Mines) and Shri Sunil Soni (Q.P).

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail
<b>Rule 11(1)</b>	<p><i>No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5.</i></p> <p>i. Only 57,400 T were produced during the reporting year 2022-23 against the approved proposal of 1,50,000 T furnished in Modification of Mining Plan dated 13.09.2022 which distorting the proposal by 62%.</p>

45(7)**

*If it is found that the holder of a mining lease or the person or company engaged in trading or storage or end-use or export of minerals, as the case may be, has submitted incomplete or wrong or false information in monthly or annual returns or fails to submit a return within the date specified; then, –*

*(a) in the case of mining of minerals by the holder of a mining lease, the Regional Controller of Mines or the authorized officer of the State Government may -*

- i. Order suspension of all mining operations and dispatches in the mine and to revoke the order of suspension only after ensuring proper compliance;*
- ii. take action to initiate prosecution under these rules;*

Geologist In charge details furnished are incorrect as your mine fall under A category and the area is more than 25 hectare full time geologist is required to appoint.

Balance reserves available as on 31.03.2023 in correctly reported with reference to the last approved Modification of Mining Plan and the subsequent depletion.

2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.

3. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within a period of 45 days from the date of issue of this letter.
