Sub.: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to your **Nanhwara Limestone Mine ( 7.035 ha), Mine Code – 38MPR18132 Distt- Katni (M.P).**

Sir,

The following provision of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during the inspection by the undersigned on 22.11.2023 in presence of Shri.

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail
<b>Rule 11(1)</b>	<p><i>No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5.</i></p> <p>i. It is observed that Mine working have been encroached the 7.5m barrier in between the boundary pillars No. BP 06 and BP 07 which does not have any common boundary at that particular area.</p> <p>ii. The mineral stack on the eastern side of the lease is extended beyond the Mining Lease boundary.</p> <p>iii. Backfilling in the pit is observed in the area which is not proposed in the approved Review of Mining Plan.</p>
<b>Rule 24(1)</b>	<p><i>The holder of a mining lease shall submit a final mine closure plan to the competent authority for approval two years prior to the proposed closure of the mine.</i></p> <p>As your lease is expiring on 04.12.2025 you are required to submit the Final Mine Closure Plan before 04.12.2023 which is not submitted yet.</p>
