The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during inspection on 13.07.2024 by the undersigned in presence of Shri. Dilip Singh Panwar, Mines Manager, Shri Yogesh Dadhich, Geologist and other mine officials:

Rule	Nature of Violations observed
45 (7)	The online Annual return for the year 2023-24 has already been submitted by the Lessee on date of inspection; Following discrepancies are noted in the submitted copies as observed during site inspection.
45 (1)	i)Part-I of AR 2023-24- There are discrepancies in the land use area as reported in Part-I (12) under 12(ii)- Covered under current(O-C) workings, 12(iv)-Used for waste disposal and 12(vi)- Used for any other purpose/Limestone Mineral Stock and are not matching with the submitted drone data, & surface KMZ plan along with Annual Return for the year 2023-24, actual field conditions & approved land use pattern of the mine plan document dated 25/11/2021.
	ii)Part-VII of AR 2023-24- The production proposal for the year 2023-24 as per the approved mine plan document is not furnished/ updated and is mentioned as "0".

- 02. The Mining operations and dispatches may be suspended and action under subrule (7) of Rule 45 of MCDR 2017 may be initiated.
- 03. The fine may also be imposed for submitting incomplete/ wrong/ false information in annual & monthly returns, as per Schedule-II under Rule 45(7A) of MCDR 2017.
- 04. In this connection, it is again brought to your notice that this violation also constitutes an

offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR 2017.

05. You are, therefore, directed to show cause within a period of thirty (30) days from the date of issue of this notice, as to why action under sub rule (7) of Rule 45 and Rule 62 of MCDR 2017 shall not be taken against you.

06. You are herewith given 30 days-time for reply and rectification of the violation from the date of issue of this notice. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
