Rule 11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of subsection (2) of section 5.
	<ul> <li>i. Mining lease Boundary pillars has not been established at the precise locations.</li> <li>ii. The exploration proposal of 06 boreholes during the year1 i.e 2023-24 has not been carried out as proposed.</li> <li>iii. Back filling of 7.5 m barrier has not been carried out as proposed</li> <li>iv. It is proposed to construct 980m length of garland drain in southern part of the lease which is not constructed.</li> <li>v. Plantation has not been carried out as proposed 500 sapling during the reporting year.</li> </ul>
