Sub. : Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to **Jariyari Bauxite Mine** over an extent of **4.0 hect.** in **Maihar district** of M.P.

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 31/05/2024 by the undersigned, accompanied by Shri Shyam Gopal Saxen, Mining Engineer and Shridhar Pandey, Geologist of the mine.

नियम	पाए गए उल्लंघन की विस्तृत प्रकृति
12(4B)	For the exploration done under sub-rule (3) and (4), the holder of mining lease shall submit to the State Government and the Indian Bureau of Mines, a Geological Study Report prepared in the manner specified in the Minerals (Evidence of Mineral Contents) Rules, 2015, within three months after the completion of the exploration work. As per approved Review of Mining Plan no. of boreholes have been carried out for the purpose. Further, 100% recovery of mineral reported in reply letter dated 28/11/2023 & 19/12/2023 against this office letter MP/Satna/Bauxite-45. dated 03/11/2023. But copy of the Geological Study Report (GSR) has not been submitted to this office even lapsing of more than a year after completion of boreholes.
31(4)	The plans and sections required under these rules shall be maintained up to date within three months in case of category 'A' mines as referred to in clause (a) of sub-rule (2) of rule 55, and within twelve months in case of any other mine The plans & sections were not found updated on quarterly basis as required under this rule and not maintained at mines site office.

- In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
- Violation of rule 12(4B) is directly related with provisions made under rule 11 considering conservation of mineral and systematic and scientific mining account. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 12(4B) of MCDR-2017 are not found satisfactory.
- You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
