Sub. : Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to Salaiya bauxite **Mine** over an extent of **16.18 hect.** in **Rewa District (M.P.)**

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 24/06/2024 by the undersigned, accompanied by Mohd. Kafil, Mining Engineer of the mine and Shri G.P.Garg, representative of lessee.

11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016. Read with MCR (Amendment), 2021 notified in Gazette of India vide dated 02/11/2021 The Review of Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No.- E 6124 MCDR-MPC0BXT/5/2023-JBP-IBM_RO_JBP dated 21/07/2023 incorporating proposal of working from 2023-24 to 2027-28 During the inspection it was found that following activities have been carried out with violating the approved proposals: - In the year 2023-24 against the approved proposal of 40008 tons bauxite production only 30335 stone of Bauxite production reportedly achieved. Thus, there is almost 25% deviation in case of production of bauxite mineral.
31(4)	The plans and sections required under these rules shall be maintained up to date within three months in case of category 'A' mines as referred to in clause (a) of sub-rule (2) of rule 55, and within twelve months in case of any other mine The plans & sections were not found updated on quarterly basis as required under this rule and not maintained at mines site office.

- In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
- The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 are not found satisfactory.
- You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
