Sub: - Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Badari Limestone and dolomite Mine over an extent of 10.246 hectares (Mine Code - 38MPR47040) situated in Village – Badari, Tehsil - Vijayrahoharh, District: - Katni of Madhya Pradesh State

Sir,

Following provisions of MCDR, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection by Shri Akash Arun Mittarwar, Assistant Mining Engineer on 29/06/2024 in the presence Shri Brijlal Prasad Mishra (Mining Engineer) & Shri Ajay Pandey (Geologist) as follows:-

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail
31(4)	The plans and sections required under these rules shall be maintained up to date 1[showing also the respective proposal of approved mining plan for various activities pertaining to that year, within three months] in case of category 'A' mines as referred to in clause (a) of sub-rule (2) of rule 55, and within twelve months in the case of any other mine.
	• The updated plans and sections are not maintained at mine site.
33	The holder of a mining lease shall, on or before the 30th day of June every year submit to the authorized Officer, as the case may be, and the State Government, a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32.
	• Copies of plans and sections under rule 32 of MCDR-2017 have not been submitted.
45(7)	If it is found that the holder of a mineral concession or the person or company engaged in trading or storage or end-use or export or import of minerals, as the case may be, has submitted incomplete or wrong or false information in monthly or annual returns or fails to submit a return within the date specified;-
	• In Annual return of 2023-24, 79200 tonnes of limestone production reported during the year but, only 33325 tonnes of reserves depleted from the assessed reserves which is false and misleading. Therefore, total reserves arrive as on 31.3.2024 are also wrong & misleading.

<sup>1.</sup> In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.

- 2. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 45(7) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 45(7) of MCDR-2017 read with MCDR-2021 (Amendment) if, not found satisfactory.
- 3. You are advised to rectify the violations of abovementioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
