**10- Details of violations observed during current inspection and compliance position of earlier violation pointed out:** - Joint inspection with Shri Manish Gupta, ACOM was carried out on 08.06.2024 for Mining plan and FMCP compliance. Following violations are observed:-

- (i) Violation observed under Rule 26(1) for less Plantation. It was found that around 1450 plants were planted which is less than proposed during the year 2023-24.
- (ii) Violation of Rule 34A for non-submission of Digital aerial images of mining lease area for the year 2023-24 was observed as lease expiring on 23.06.2024.
- (iii) As Mining Lease period is expiring on 23.06.2024, therefore a letter has been sent to the lessee for seeking needful information under Rule 67 of MCDR 2017.
