Sub.: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to Aber Limestone Mine (17.408 ha), Mine Code – 38MPR35284 Distt-Satna (M.P).

The following provision of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during the inspection by the undersigned on 08/07/2023 in presence of your representative Shri. Sudheer Singh Tomar.

Rule 11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of subsection (2) of section 5.
	1. Only 289220 Tonnes of Limestone was produced against the proposed production of 392400 Tonnes during 2022-2023 which distorting the proposal by 26%.
	2. Bench width of about 3 meters is observed; against to maintain more than 6 meters (Bench height), thus benches are not systematically developed as proposed.
	3. For the proposal year the Waste dumping proposed in between E 500656 to E 500756 whereas the actual dumping found deviation in the approved location.
