Sub.: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to your **Chhapparwah Dolomite & Limestone Mine, Mine code 19MPR18013 over an area of 19.716 hect** in Katni District of M.P.

Sir,

The following provision of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during the inspection by the undersigned on 29.02.2024 in presence of Shri. Bijay jaishwal(Mine Manager) and Shri Prem Bushan Verma (Mining Engineer).

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail
Rule 11(1)	<p><i>No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5.</i></p> <p>i. Against the proposed 4,04,984 T of Dolomite only 1,68,158 T produced which distorting the proposal by 58 %.</p> <p>ii. Backfilling in the pit is observed in the area which is not proposed in the approved Review of Mining Plan.</p>
Rule 12(4)	<p><i>(3) The holder of a mining lease shall carry out detailed exploration (G1 level) over the entire potentially mineralized area under the mining lease, within a period of five years from the date of opening of the mine after execution of such mining lease.</i></p> <p><i>(4) In the case of existing mining leases detailed exploration (G1 level) over the entire potentially mineralised area under the mining lease shall be carried out within a period of five years from the date of commencement of these rules i.e 27 Feb 2022.</i></p> <p>The lease area has not been explored to bring the potentially mineralized area under G1 level as proposed in the approved document.</p>

Rule 31(4)	<p><i>The plans and sections required under these rules shall be maintained up to date within three months in case of category 'A' mines as referred to in clause (a) of sub-rule (2) of rule 55, and within twelve months in the case of any other mine.</i></p> <p>The plans and sections have not been updated as required.</p>
