Pursuant to issuance of CBIC Notification No. 25/2024-Central Tax dated 09.10.2024, it may be noted that necessary compliance for the payment relating to Tax Deduction at Source under Section 51 of the CGST Act, 2017 on metal scrap, wherever applicable, is to be dealt directly by the Buyer with Seller. TDS at the rate of 2% under GST is applicable only when seller and buyer are both registered under GST as regular taxpayer. Since GST TDS is a compliance matter pertaining to the buyer & seller only, MSTC Limited as a Service Provider will not intervene in the matter. Accordingly, the payment is to be done strictly as per the Payment Schedule mentioned in the auction catalogue.

This supersedes General and Buyer specific terms and conditions wherever applicable.

GST: Reverse Charge Mechanism

1. Only those bidders who are registered with GST authority and a having valid GST registration no. should participate in this auction. The other bidders will not be allowed to participate in the auction and no complaint in this regard shall be entertained
2. As per notification no.36/2017 central tax (rate) dated 13.10.2017 and Notification no.37/2017 integrated tax (rate) dated 13.10.2017, principal/seller being Govt. Unit, GST and cess on goods will be deposited by buyer under reverse Charge mechanism.
3. It is the responsibility of the buyer to submit true copy of Gst certificate to the principal before taking delivery.
4. Seller has to ensure collection of true copy of GST Certificate from the registered buyers before giving delivery of goods to them.
5. The GST as applicable on the date of delivery shall be paid by the successful bidder and GST and Cess on such Goods shall be paid on Reverse Charge basis by the Registered Recipient.

Material are sold on the assumption that bidders have inspected the same and know what they are buying, irrespective of whether they have first inspected the materials or not. No complain shall be entertained in this regard. The material offered for sale can be inspected prior to the due date of e-auction. 4.0) **PAYMENT DETAILS:**

4.1) The successful bidders shall submit Earnest Money Deposit(EMD) by way of **challan through Bharatkosh to Seller/IBM** or as mentioned in the lot description/Sale intimation Letter fired to your mail within 7 days of confirmation of bid for Accepted Lots and within 7 days from the date of acceptance of the item/s by seller for Lots under STA. The EMD must be **@10%** of the net sale Value quoted (excluding taxes & and duties). Upon issue of the sale order the EMD shall automatically be converted into Security Deposit. The Security Deposit as specified in Sale Order shall be adjusted only at the time of final payment. 9.0) Bidder shall submit his/ their Income Tax clearance certificate (latest), partnership deed of organizations and when demanded by MSTC/ owners.

10.0) The Bidders/ customers' workmen shall have to abide by the rules& regulation including safety & security regulation of the relevant statutory acts. Entry inside the works / stores should only be against Gate pass for the men and equipment for which purchaser will have to apply well in advance before lifting commences.

11.0) The Buyer will employ his own labour and means; at his own cost and risk for removal/collection/shifting of scrap as per schedules and payment of wages/compensation to the labourers will be the sole responsibility of the buyer. The purchaser shall ensure that his workmen do not loiter around within the stores area of the factory areas. They shall not touch any material except those material shown to them. If any of his workmen is even found violating these restriction, the purchaser shall be responsible for making good the loss to the owners on which their decision shall be final and binding.

12.0) **LATE PAYMENT PENALTY :** For any delay in making payment within the time limit specified, the due payment may be made together with late penalty @ 1% per week or part thereof on the Sale Value for the period of delay within 14 days from the due date and thereafter on the sole discretion of PRINCIPAL only.
