Sir,

The undersigned carried out virtual inspection of your mine on 06/01/2025 based on your submitted drone data and available information as per office records and following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine.

Rules	Nature of Violations observed
45 (7)	<p>The online Annual return for the year 2023-24 has already been submitted by the Lessee on date of virtual inspection; Following discrepancies are noted in the submitted copy.</p> <p>a) Part-I(General)- The land use (area in ha) as reported in Part-I (12) under 12(ii) i.e., Covered under current(O/C) workings, 12(iv) i.e., used for waste disposal & 12(v) i.e., Occupied by plant, buildings, residential, welfare buildings and roads have not been reported correctly in accordance with approved land use pattern of the last mine plan document dtd. 15/12/2023.</p> <p>b) Part-V (General Geology & Mining): The Reserve and Resources mentioned in Part-V (2.) under UNFC code 111, 122, 211, 222 & 333 have not been reported correctly as per the latest approved mine plan document dated 15/12/2023.</p> <p>c) Part-VII (Cost of Production): The production proposal for the year 2023-24 as per the approved mine plan document is not updated and is</p>

mentioned as "0".

02. The Mining operations and dispatches may be suspended and action under subrule (7) of Rule 45 of MCDR 2017 may be initiated.

03. The fine may also be imposed for submitting incomplete/ wrong/ false information in annual & monthly returns, as per Schedule-II under Rule 45(7A) of MCDR 2017.

04. In this connection, it is again brought to your notice that this violation also constitutes an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR 2017.

05. You are, therefore, directed to show cause within a period of thirty (30) days from the date of issue of this notice, as to why action under sub rule (7) of Rule 45 and Rule 62 of MCDR 2017 shall not be taken against you.

06. You are herewith given 30 days-time for reply and rectification of the violation from the date of issue of this notice. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
