Sub: - Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Sagar Cements Limestone Mine-I, over an extent of 326.58Ha. Situated in Pedaveedu, village, Mandal- Mattampally, District- Suryapet of Telangana State.

Sir,

The following provision of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection **on 03/10/2024**, by Kalmata M.K, Regional Mining Geologist, in presence of Shri Subramanya V., Mines Manager & Md.Nayeem, Geologist.

Rule	Nature of Violation observed
45(7)	<p>Following deficiencies were observed in the annual returns submitted for the year 2023-24.</p> <p>a) As proposed under PMCP, 1.20Ha of land is utilized for development of green belt in the year 2023-24 and total area covered under green belt so far is 46.10Ha, however area utilized for green belt is not mentioned under point no 12(vii) of part I.</p> <p>b) The mine is working and paid royalty in the year 2023-24 and not paid any dead rent in the year 2023-24, however dead rent is shown by simply multiplying total lease area and applicable dead rent rate per Ha.</p> <p>c) As per the direction given by Head quarter, in case of captive consumption of the ore, then sale value to be given quantity dispatched multiply by examine price. However, lessee has shown sale value as zero.</p>

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence, punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR, 2017.

03. For Non-submission or incomplete/ wrong/ false information in annual returns by the due date, an amount of Rs 10, 000/day to be paid, after due date of submission of return as specified

in the Rule till rectification of violation as per Schedule-II of MCDR -2017 (Amended up to 21st January 2024).

04. The mining operations and dispatches can be suspended under Rule 45(7) (a)(i), if compliance of MCD Rules 2017 (Amended up to 3rd November 2021) is not found satisfactory, or prosecution can be made, or both can be done.

05. You are advised to rectify the above violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within 30 days from the date of issue of this letter.

06. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
