Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 (amended) was found violated in your above mine during the MCDR & SDF inspection on 06.12.204 by Shri D. Chandrasekhar Reddy, Asst. Mining Engineer accompanied by Shri Radhakrishnan, AGM (Mines) and Shri Selvakumar, Geologist.

- 02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62(1) of MCDR, 2017.
- 03. The mining operations can be suspended under Rule 11(2) if compliance of rule is not found satisfactory.
- 04. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
