Subject: - Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Bistara limestone Mine over an area of 17.07 Hectares, Mine code-38MPR18134 situated in Katni district of M.P. State.

Sir,

Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your above mine based on the inspection by the Undersigned on 17/01/2025 in the presence of Shri Krishna Kumar Chandra (Mining Engineer), Shri. Ratnesh Kumar Pandey (Mine Geologist):

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail
11(1)	<p>No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government.</p> <p>The Modification of Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No. MP/Katni/Limestone/MPLN/MOD-02/2020-21 dated 06/08/2020 incorporating proposal of working from 2020-21 to 2024-25 and following deviations have been observed :</p> <p>(a) Only 51880 tonnes of limestone production is achieved against the proposal of 80400 tonnes for the year 2023-24.</p> <p>(b) Only 6585 m³ of OB generation is achieved against the proposal of 36729 m³ of OB for the year 2023-24.</p> <p>(c) Only 100 m³ of Topsoil generation is achieved against the proposal of 784 m³ of Topsoil for the year 2023-24.</p> <p>Hence the development & excavation measures were not carried out with respect to the approved proposals.</p>

- In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
- The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 read with MCDR-2021 (Amendment) is not found satisfactory.
- You are advised to rectify the violations of abovementioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
