Subject: - Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Nanhwara Limestone Mine over an extent of 7.035 hect, Mine Code: - 38MPR18132 in Katni District of M.P.

Sir, Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your above mine based on the examination of submitted Drone imagery and inspection by the Undersigned on 01/08/24 in the presence Shri Krishna Nand Ojha (Mining Engineer), Shri Shidhar Pandey (Mine Geologist) & Mine officials:

Rule	Nature of violation observed in detail

11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government.
	The Initial Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No. MP/ Katni /Limestone/RMP-42/19-20 dated 01/07/2020 incorporating proposal of working from 2020-21 to 2024-25 and following deviations have been observed:
	(a) Refer Page 43 to 44 of Chapter No.4.0, during the year 2023-24 it was proposed to carryout development/excavation in the eastern part of the lease between the local-coordinates N 545 - N 680 & E 500- E 630. But during the year, the said development was observed between N 545 - N 680 & E 480- E 470 resulting in lateral deviations towards the eastern part of the lease area.
	(b) Nil topsoil is reported against the proposal of 46356 m3 of topsoil generation for the year 2023-24.
	(c) During the examination of drone image and inspection, the plantation which was proposed between BP-10 to BP -09 during the proposal period was not carried out wrt approved proposals.
	Hence the excavation & PMCP measures were found lagging behind the approved proposals.
45(7)	The holder of a mining lease shall submit online returns in respect of each mine to the Regional Controller or any other authorised official of the Indian Bureau of Mines in the following manner.  An annual return which shall be submitted before the 1st day of July each year for the preceding financial year in electronic form, along with a signed print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the respective Form.  The following discrepancies found in your submitted annual return for the year 2023-24:  PART-1 S.No.12. The details wrt to work done under progressive mine closure plan during the year is incorrectly furnished.  The .kml file attached is incomplete and necessary surface features as per the updated surface plan are not marked.  PART-5 S.No.05 (Trees planted- survival rate). The details wrt to total no.of trees at the end of the year is incorrectly furnished.

- 1. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
- 2. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) & 45(7) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) & 45(7) of MCDR-2017 read with MCDR-2021 (Amendment) is not found satisfactory.
- 3. You are advised to rectify the violations of abovementioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
