Sub.: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to your **Chulhi-Majhiyar Limestone Mine (Mine Code 38MPR35358)** over an extent **176.619 hectares** situated in village Chulhi Majhiyar, Rewa District of Madhya Pradesh State

Sir,

The following provision of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during the inspection by the undersigned on 18.01.2025 in presence of **Dharmendra Kumar Singh, Mines Manager** and **Santosh Kumar- Geologist**

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail
Rule 11(1).	<p><i>Mining operations under mining lease.-(1) No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 During inspection it has been observed that the following provisions of the rule have been violated: -</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> It is proposed to 19 bore holes drilled during the Reporting Year against which only 13 bore holes reported. Against the proposed Top Soil quantity of 33332 Cu.m only 4836 Cu.m is handling reported. Against the proposed OB generation of 107356 Cu.m only 27409 Cu.m of waste handling is reported. Only 34500 T limestone production reported against the proposed quantity of 500000 which distorting the proposals by 93%. Backfilling has not been carried out as proposed for the reporting year.

2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
3. Non-compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR, 2017 may lead to suspension of mining operation under the provision of rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017.
4. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within a period of 45 days from the date of issue of this letter.
