Subject:- Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect of your **Kakra Panna Limestone Mine, over an area of 1594.34 hectare**, situated in village-Harduakena, Tehsil : Amanganj , District Panna - of Madhya Pradesh State.

Sir,

Undersigned has inspected your mine in the presence of your representative Shri Suresh Wandhare, Head (Mines), Yogender Kumar (Geologist), Shri Indraneel Dhawande (QP) on 08/11/2024. The Review Mining plan for above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No. E 12104 MCDR-MPC0LST/43/2024-JBP-IBM_RO_JBP dated 13/01/2025.

Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your mines at the time of inspection.

| 36(3) of MCDR 2017 | <p>Removal and utilisation of top soil : Whenever the top soil is unable to be utilised concurrently, it shall be stored separately for future use.</p> <p>Dumping of top soil not done properly, it was dumped with Overburden.</p> |

- In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
- The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
- You are advised to rectify the violations of above mentioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
