Subject:- Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect your **Ukwa Manganese Mine** over an area **69.581 Ha** in Balaghat district of M.P. State.

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during inspection on 10/05/2024. The document of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No.-MP/Balaghat/Manganese/RMP-34/19-20 dated 28/2/2020 incorporating proposal of working from 2020-21 to 2024-25.

During the year 2022-23, it was proposed to produce 100000 T of Mn ore but only 9910 T of Mn ore produced. 2. During the year 2023-24, it was proposed to produce 110000 T of Mn ore but only 69554 T of Mn ore produced. 3. During the year 2022-23 and 23-24 stoping was proposed between 1750'L to 1850'L, 1650'L to 1750'L and 1550'L to 1650'L. But no stoping applications for above mentioned levels are submitted till date. 4. At many places safety barrier of 7.5 is not maintained and excavation is done out side the lease also. |

1. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
2. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
3. You are, therefore, directed to show cause within a period of 30 days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above offences.
