Sub: - Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Sultanpur Thanda Limestone Mine, over an extent of 42.83Ha. Situated in Pedaveedu Village, Mandal -Mattampalli, and Suryapet-District of Telangana State.

Sir,

The following provision of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 12.09.2024, by Shri Kalmata. M.K, Regional Mining Geologist, in presence of Shri.G.S.Subba Rao, Mines Manager.

Rule	Nature of Violation observed
11(1)	<p>No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016.</p> <p>The following deviations were observed in the mine with reference to approvals accorded in the approved Review of Mining Plan dated 08-04-2021.</p> <p>i) In the year 2023-24 there was a proposal to produce limestone between the co-ordinates N1848250 to N 1848755 & E 376580 to E 377030. However, it is observed that working has been carried out between the co-ordinates N1848360 to 1848940 and E 376600 to 376900. In the Eastern side working is not carried out up to the</p>


	proposed area, but production is achieved by advancing the benches in the North-Eastern and South-Western side of the lease.
12(4B)	Lessee has submitted Geological report on 17-07-2023, after completion of exploration. However, the details of exploration carried out furnished in the GR vary from page to page. And the data is not matching with the details furnished in the approved document with reference to borehole numbers and meterage given. Further, in the Geological report submitted to this office, it is observed that, the reserves/resources are not properly estimated by projecting correct exploration data.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence, punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR, 2017.

03. The mining operations can be suspended under Rule 11(2), if compliance of MCD Rules 2017 is not found satisfactory, or prosecution can be made, or both can be done.

04. You are advised to rectify the above violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-five) days from the date of issue of this letter.


