Subject : Violation of provision of Mineral Conservation and Development Rule, 2017 in respect of your SULTANPURA THANDA Limestone Mine (38APR14039) over an extent of 42.83 ha in Peddaveedu (V) Mattapalle (M) Suryapeta (Dist.) Telangana.

Sir, The following provision of Mineral conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in the above mine during analysis of submitted drone data for 2023-24 ,2022-23 and accordingly field inspection was carried out by Shri Ejaj Ahmad Khan (Assistant Mining Geologist) on 12.03.2025 in presence of the mine official Shri G. Ganesh (Mining Engineer).
