Subject : Violation of provision of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your KAYAD lead zinc mining lease(34RAJ01001) over an extent of 480.45 ha in Kayad in AJMER, Ajmer, Rajasthan

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 (hereinafter referred to as the MCDR, 2017) were found to have been violated in your mine during the inspection conducted on 26/08/2025 & 27/08/2025 by the undersigned in the presence of Shri Sh. Chinni Ravi Tej, Mining Engineer, and Ms. Shail Shree Bhargava, Geologist and Sh Ankur Mandawat, Mines Manager of your mine.

2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of the MCDR, 2017. In case of non-compliance with the aforesaid rules of the MCDR, 2017, the following action may be initiated against you under the provisions of the MCDR, 2017: (i) All operations of your mine may be suspended. (ii) Prosecution may be initiated against you. (iii) Recommendation for termination of the mining lease to the State Government. 3. You are advised to rectify the violation of Rule 11(1) of the MCDR, 2017 at the earliest and to inform this office about the compliance status within forty-five (45) days from the date of issue of this letter. 3. The violation pointed out above under Rule 45(7) of the MCDR, 2017 shall be treated as a show-cause notice, and you are hereby granted 30 days' time to rectify the same. 4. Therefore, you are directed to show cause within thirty (30) days from the date of issue of this letter/notice as to why action under Rule 45(7) and Rule 62 of the MCDR, 2017 should not be initiated against you. 5. Please note that no further notice will be issued to you for violation of Rule 45(7) of the MCDR, 2017. In case of noncompliance, the provisions of Schedule-II under Rule 45(7A) of the MCDR, 2017 shall be applicable.
