Sir, The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 read with MCDR (Amendment), 2021 were found violated in respect of the above said mine during inspection on 17.09.2025 by the undersigned, in presence of Mr. D.N Parida, Agent, Mr. Suryakanta Panda, Mines Manager, Mr. Sanjaya Kumar Prusty, Mining Engineer, Mr. Pritam Keshari Patra, Geologist and other mining officials.
