In case of violation of Rule 45, a) Constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62(1) of MCDR 2017 and/or; b) You are also liable to pay such amount as prescribed under MCDR 2017 for delay of each day as per Schedule-II, read with Rule 45(7A) in case of non-compliance of various provisions of Rule 45. c) As per provision of Rule 45(7) and/or45(7A)(ii) the Regional Controller of Mines may take appropriate action including order of suspension of all mining operations and dispatches on non-compliance of various provisions of Rule 45. 3. In context to the violations of Rule 45, this letter has been considered as show cause
