**Subject:** Violation of provision of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Bohar Limestone Mine ( 38HPR10008) over an extent of 4.15 ha in Bohar-Banor in Sirmaur, Himachal Pradesh.

Undersigned has inspected above mentioned mine in the presence of mine representative Shri A K Chabra and Shri Shrinivas Pandey for the submitted self assesment star rating template. During the inspection it was observed that mining operations in the mine was not carried out in accordance with the proposals given in the last approved Mining Plan. Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your mines at the time of inspection.

You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
